

My Child already receives infant free school meals!

From September 2014, children who are in Reception, Year 1 or Year 2 qualified for universal free school meals.

However, this does not mean they qualify for all the other benefits that we offer to Pupil Premium children.

Free school meals and Pupil Premium benefits are available to children of families who are in receipt of:

- income Support
- income Based Jobseekers Allowance
- an income-related employment and support allowance
- support under part V1 of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- the Guarantee element of State Pension Credit
- child Tax Credit, provided they are not entitled to Working Tax Credit and have an annual income (as assessed by HM Revenue & Customs) that does not exceed £16,190

If you receive any of the above PLEASE call into the office and Miss Webb will be happy to help you complete the form. Applying for free school meals (even if your child already receives a free lunch or prefers sandwiches) means they will receive additional benefits that you are entitled to!

How is the Pupil Premium grant used?

As a school we use the Pupil Premium Grant in many ways to help support the children.

These include:

- Keeping class sizes small and have a good proportion of support staff working in classes.
- Hire specialist support from external agencies (e.g an educational psychologist).
- Brain booster sessions after school for Y5 and Y6 pupils.
- Subsidised trips and residentials.
- Book week vouchers.
- Free after school clubs.
- Purchase additional learning resources.
