1. Research Sutton Hoo. Present your findings as creatively as you can.
  2. Write a poem about a Viking. Practice reciting it at home to show the class.
  3. Research and create a traditional recipe from a European country with an adult.
  4. Create a Viking long ship using whichever materials you like.
  5. Watch <https://www.bbc.co.uk/education/clips/znjqxnb> Design a poster to encourage other people to watch the video.
  6. Design or create a Viking helmet using whichever materials you like
  7. Stage an interview with a Viking warrior, either film your interview or write down what was asked and said.
  8. Research and compare 2 European countries.
  9. Imagine you are an Anglo-Saxon, recently arrived in Britain. Write a letter home describing your first impressions.
  10. Use Viking runes to write a secret message to the class.
  11. Create a game to help you to remember the flags and capital cities of European countries.
  12. Create a timeline for Britain during the Viking and Anglo-Saxon period.
  13. Draw a diagram of the ear.
  14. Create your own musical instrument.
  15. Draw and describe a Viking God. Why was he/ she so important to the Vikings?
  16. Design your own Saxon village.
  17. Create your own map showing the routes travelled by the Vikings.
  18. Find a recipe for a traditional Viking or Anglo-Saxon meal, have a go at creating it with an adult.
