Below you will find 10 dragon/adventure themed homework tasks. Each week you must choose 1 of these tasks and bring it in with your book on the due date. You may do them in any order you wish. You will not have enough weeks to do them all, so choose carefully. Not every piece has to be written down in your homework book. Homework could be in the form of a model/video/photo etc. I can't wait to see what you create, Mr Amps.

⇒ Create your own dragon model or puppet with moving wings.

⇒ Draw a picture of your own dragon and label its different features using impressive vocabulary. E.g. Radiant, graceful wings.

⇒ Create a map of a place you know well. (Include a key)

⇒ Create your own dragon egg collage using any material you wish.
 your materials to make it look as if the egg has scales?



⇒ Ice dragons can be found flying around the peaks of Mt. Everest, rain dragons can be spotted in the deepest parts of the Amazon Rainforest and sand dragons often lurk in the Sahara Desert. Choose a habitat and search for 10 interesting facts to share with the class. Can you think of an interesting way to display these facts?

⇒ Before going on any adventure it's important to check the weather, so you know what to pack. Record your own weather report for a country of your choice. Include cities, temperatures, weather and surrounding countries.

⇒ Adventurers need to be able to keep track of time. Create your own moving clock then use this to practice reading the minute hand to the nearest 5 minutes. (O'clock, 5 past, 10 past quarter past, etc.)

⇒ Looking for dragons. Label these countries on a map, find out how long it would take to fly there from London and order them from shortest to longest flight. {
Canada, Brazil, Sweden, Ireland, South Africa, India, Iceland }

⇒ Go on your own mini adventure. Sketch any interesting trees/flowers you can find. You could even take rubbings of different shaped leaves you find.

⇒ Find and follow a recipe for a snack that you could take on a dragon adventure. It should be lasting, easy to keep in your bag and provide lots of energy.
