- Word recognition.




SPELLING

- Spelling Shed and the Spelling Menu can be used to support at home, but find the way that works best for your child.
- Little and often.
- Year 2 "challenge words". See the list of year 2 word which children are expected to be able to read and write.
- Don't ask me about steak!



PHONICS

- *Most children starting on phase 5.*
- In the new year, we will move to phase 6. Phase 6 covers suffixes, prefixes and a range of spelling patterns.
- Phonics Screening in December.
- Real and nonsense words.
- Daily rapid phonics lessons.
