The main aim of Asfordby Hill Primary School (FOAH) is to raise funds in order to enhance our children's school life and extra-curricular activities.

## Fundraising

Our main events include both a summer and Christmas Fair. Alongside these we also organise school discos, 'Break the Rules' Day, bingo nights, film nights and day trips out.

The money raised has enabled us to contribute to school outings such as theatre trips for the children, equipment and materials to enhance our children's school life and extra-curricular activities.

For example, we were able to use our funds to buy a subscription to the 'Seesaw' online tool for learning at home which proved invaluable during 'lockdown', and continues to support children's home learning. ⇒

## Splitting the £1.00

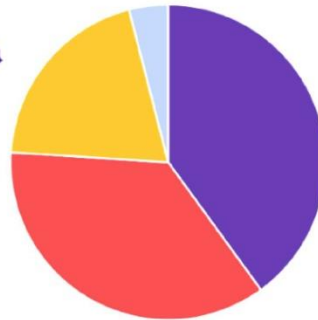
## How it works...
