

# WILLOW'S SPRING TERM CURRICULUM LETTER

Dear Parents/Carers,

Welcome back to the Spring Term. I hope you had an enjoyable Christmas break. I am looking forward to another busy term. This term's learning includes:

PHONICS

WORKING ON:

READING AND SPELLING A WIDE RANGE OF WORDS USING ALL LETTERS AND LESS FREQUENT CONSONANT DIGRAPHS AND LONG VOWEL PHONEMES; SEGMENTING ADJACENT CONSONANTS IN WORDS AND APPLY THIS IN SPELLING AND APPLY THIS SKILL WHEN READING UNFAMILIAR WORDS; READING PHONETICALLY DECODABLE TWO-SYLLABLE AND THREE-SYLLABLE WORDS; USING ALTERNATIVE WAYS OF PRONOUNCING AND SPELLING THE GRAPHEMES CORRESPONDING TO THE LONG VOWEL PHONEMES; SPELLING COMPLEX WORDS USING PHONETICALLY PLAUSIBLE ATTEMPTS. Use a graphics editing program to create digital images to design and make a rocket. MUSIC


